LIFE ARTISAN's objectives

Strategic objective

Support the implementation and drafting of the 3rd National Climate Change Adaptation Plan (NAP3) and the National Strategy for Biodiversity 2030



Specific objective:

Create the conditions for the widespread use NbS for climate change adaptation within eight years

Stakeholder involvement - The regional facilitation

Key of success

- ✓ Facilitate regional governance/network, **bringing together stakeholders** in the fields of **biodiversity and climate**
- ✓ **Contribute to the training** of network leaders capable of promoting NbS
- ✓ Place the issue of NbS on the agenda of key regional stakeholders, to increase financing and technical support
- ✓ **Raise awareness** among elected representatives and decision-makers through regional or national **events**
- ✓ National network of diverse experts (urban, coastal, etc.) supporting each other.

Some results:

- **~250 people** are taking part in **regional working groups** on NbS
- **~20,000 participants** in events organised by the facilitators or to which they have contributed.
- Various **television reports and press articles**
- **Serious games** and other formats of awareness-raising **workshops**
